

### Course description

---

The aim of the course is to introduce students to, or extend students' knowledge of, significant twentieth and twenty-first century writers, bearing in mind the connections these texts have with texts of the Modern past, as well as with the social, political and cultural moment in which they were written. Texts will therefore be contextualized and read taking into account literary-critical perspectives such as new historicism, cultural studies, feminist, gay and lesbian and queer theory as well as a more traditional close-reading approach.

In general, reading will be done outside class time. In class, discussions and activities of various kinds, will seek to encourage informed, personal response to texts. Written assignments will consist of essay- type questions.

Although we have a reading list, in part put together by students of the previous year, this is flexible, allowing for personal taste – or distaste – to set the pace for reading.
